

The Christian County Health Department seeks candidates for a full-time Environmental Public Health Specialist (EPHS). Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with course work (30 semester hours minimum) in environmental health, biology, bacteriology, or sanitary science or in combination of these areas. One year of environmental health experience is preferred. Possession of Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) or Missouri Certified Environmental Health Specialist (CEHS). The EPHS is responsible for inspections relating to environmental public health programs, including the following: on-site wastewater treatment systems; food safety inspection; child care facility sanitation and safety; commercial lodging sanitation and safety; environmental public health factors related to disaster response and/or food transportation accidents; response to food recalls and/or other duties as assigned.
