



## Christian County Health Department Reports Follow-up Information Concerning Positive COVID-19 Case

Christian County Health Department reports that after investigation of the positive cases of COVID-19 reported on March 18, 2020; one of the cases presents a low risk of spread of the infection to the general public. This patient and their household contacts are in quarantine.

Concerning the second case; a precautionary notification is being issued to the residents of Christian County and surrounding areas.

It appears that the patient was exposed to the virus while in the company of a group of international travelers that tested positive for COVID-19. Patient isolated himself as soon as symptoms developed. In an abundance of caution, we are providing the community with information that the patient indicates attendance during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Service of South Campus James River Church in Ozark, MO on March 8, 2020. Patient was not symptomatic during that time and did not develop symptoms until four days later on March 12, 2020. While risk of exposure is low because the patient was not symptomatic, we would like to notify attendees of this service that if they currently have or develop any symptoms that could be associated with COVID-19 they should contact their healthcare provider.

Symptoms to watch for include:

- Fever
- Dry Cough
- Difficulty Breathing
