### **Christian County Announces Timeline of Exposures to a COVID-19 Case**

The Christian County Health Department is notifying the public of possible exposure from an individual testing positive for COVID-19. The individual visited the following locations:

- Tuesday, June 3 or Wednesday, June 4 (the individual could not recall the exact date): Evolution Fitness, 2298 Walk on Drive in Ozark between 8:00 pm-9:00 pm
- Tuesday, June 3: Kum & Go, 5552 N 21st Street in Ozark around 9:00 am for a brief amount of time
- Wednesday, June 4: Price Cutter, 5504 N 17th Street in Ozark around 8:00 pm for approximately 20 minutes

Anyone who was at the locations on the dates and times listed above is at low risk for contracting COVID-19, but should monitor for symptoms. There is no need to self-quarantine or isolate unless symptoms develop. COVID-19 is spread through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. It spreads between people who are in close contact with one another.

Anyone who develops symptoms of COVID-19 should contact their health care provider regarding testing and should take all necessary precautions to avoid exposing others.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
