### **One New COVID-19 Case Confirmed in Christian County**

One new case of COVID-19 has been confirmed in Christian County. While investigators have not been able to link the new case to another positive case, this case was exposed to an individual who was symptomatic but had not been tested for COVID-19. The individual has been instructed to isolate at home until they meet Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) criteria for release. Close contacts of the case have been identified and instructed to quarantine at home as well.

Christian County currently has a cumulative total of forty-seven (47) COVID-19 cases (forty-one (41) confirmed and six (6) probable), with twelve (12) active cases being monitored.

The health department continues to remind all residents to practice social distancing while out in public areas, wear a face mask or other face covering if social distancing is not possible, practice good hand hygiene, and avoid crowded areas or large gatherings. In addition, anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home and seek medical attention.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include: · Fever or chills · Cough · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing · Fatigue · Muscle or body aches · Headache · New loss of taste or smell · Sore throat · Congestion or runny
