Three New COVID-19 Cases Confirmed in Christian County

Three (3) new case of COVID-19 have been confirmed in Christian County. Two (2) of the cases are considered to be community spread due to investigators being unable to link the cases to another positive case. The third case is still under investigation.

All three (3) individuals have been instructed to quarantine at home until they meet Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) criteria for release. Close contacts of each case have been identified and instructed to quarantine at home as well.

This brings Christian County's cumulative total number of COVID-19 cases to fifty (50) (forty-four (44) confirmed and six (6) probable), with fifteen (15) active cases being monitored.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

In order to help prevent or stop the spread of COVID-19 the health department encourages all citizens to:

- Stay at home if you are ill, and contact your physician
- Practice social distancing while out in the community
- Avoid large gatherings and crowded places
- Continue wearing a face mask or other face covering while out in public areas
- Practice good hand hygiene
