Christian County Reports Fourteen Additional Cases

Christian County Health Department is announcing fourteen (14) additional COVID-19 cases. The newest cases are a mixture of community spread cases and cases linked to previously identified positive cases. To date, Christian County has a cumulative total of eighty-five (85) cases (seventy-five (75) confirmed and ten (10) probable). Forty-seven (47) active cases are currently being monitored.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include: · Fever or chills · Cough · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing · Fatigue · Muscle or body aches · Headache · New loss of taste or smell · Sore throat · Congestion or runny nose. Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home and seek medical attention.

The health department would like to remind residents that COVID-19 is still circulation in our community. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the COVID-19 virus. In order to help decrease your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19, the health department recommends that you practice social distancing while out in public areas, **wear a face mask or other face covering** if social distancing is not possible, practice good hand hygiene, and avoid crowded areas or large gatherings
